The Resident Services Department

Resident Services aims to promote resident service programs that improve the quality of life of our clients, with an emphasis on promoting their dignity, well-being, and self-sufficiency.

The purpose of our services and programs is to introduce educational opportunities for children, economic advancement for adults, and experiences that enrich and strengthen families.

Resident Initiative Programs

Family Self-Sufficiency Program

Assists families in achieving economic independence & self-sufficiency through one-on-one case management & goal setting.



Youth Enrichment Programs

We are committed to supporting our youth participants with a variety of free or low-cost resources, including academic support and enrichment activities throughout the year.

Tools for School

Tools for School is a free event for HACSB youth and families aimed at providing academic and other school-related resources to families in advance of the new school year. Held annually in August.

Academic Support & Case Management Services

Case management and academic support is available for HACSB youth in grades 7-12 on an ongoing basis and by appointment.

Youth Opportunity Fund

The Youth Opportunity Fund provides one-time financial assistance to help low-income HACSB families meet the costs of educational and/or enrichment opportunities for youth during the school year or summer.

Partner Agencies

HACSB collaborates with various local agencies to provide additional resources and support to HACSB youth.

Summer Programs

HACSB provides summer programming, including Preparación, Bienestar y Cultura, CASA Camp, Camp Firework, and SB Botanic Garden Scholarships for HACSB youth.



Supportive Services Programs

Our Supportive Services Program includes comprehensive case management services by professional staff aimed at assisting HACSB clients in maintaining successful tenancies. *Access to supportive services is free, confidential and voluntary.*

Furniture Closet

Provides donated household items to families & individuals assisted by HACSB.

Advocate-of-the-Day

Personalized guidance and assistance to resolve questions about HACSB and community services.

Healthy Food Pantry

Monthly food distribution of a bag of nonperishable food and fresh produce.

Empowerment Workshops

Seasonal workshops on topics such as financial literacy, emotional intelligence, job-acquisition, and vehicle purchasing.
